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Do you need somewhere to go to get away from it all?

Glasgow Drug Crisis Centre now has a '**Safe Haven**' which is open to drug users who need some space. It's a welcoming place where you can get a tea or a coffee and have a chat.

**Safe Haven** is not intended to put you under pressure to talk about your drug use, but we can give you informal advice on harm reduction and anything else that you see as important to you. You won't be asked a lot of questions and we will only need to know a first name.

Open between 6pm and 8pm seven days a week, you don't need an appointment you can just turn up. It's at **Glasgow Drug Crisis Centre** at **123 West Street** in **Tradeston**, Glasgow, a short walk from the River Clyde. *(If you would rather be discreet you can use the entrance on Tradeston Street.)*

If you need a bit of time out, **Safe Haven** is the perfect place to relax or to find some answers to questions you may have.
