What is Renfrewshire Housing Support Service?

We believe that supporting people to maintain a tenancy can provide a place of safety and security for the individual.



By sustaining a tenancy, service users are in a better position to access community support, health care and social benefits. We understand that there are many factors that can contribute to an individual experiencing homelessness therefore staff will offer support to individuals with complex needs.

What type of support is offered?

Staff will offer support to enhance or develop skills to maintain a tenancy. This involves help with:

- *Budgeting*
- *Shopping*
- *Meal Preparation*
- *Security and door management*
- *Help with budgeting*
- *Attending appointments*
- *Accessing employment and training opportunities*

- *Accessing local resources and social opportunities*
- *We also support people to access specialist services and break down barriers and trust issues they may have previously faced.*



Who is the service for?

We provide housing support to people who are aged 18 years and over, are homeless or are at risk of becoming homeless in the Renfrewshire area.
