We provide housing support to people who are aged 18 years and over, who have mental health issues and also may have issues with addictions.

## What type of support is offered?

Staff will offer support to enhance or develop skills to maintain a tenancy. This involves help with:

- *Budgeting*
- *Shopping*
- *Meal preparation*
- *Security and door management*
- *Attending appointments*
- *Accessing employment and training opportunities*
- *Accessing local resources and social opportunities*
- *We also support people to access specialist services and break down barriers and trust issues they may have previously faced.*



## Staffing

The service consists of a Service Manager, Service Coordinator, Housing Management Support Worker, Practitioners and Support Workers
